The Cinema of Francesco Rosi Gaetana Marrone, 2020 Francesco Rosi is one of the great realist artists of post-war Italian, indeed post-war world cinema. In this book, author Gaetana Marrone explores the rich visual language in which the Neapolitan filmmaker expresses the cultural icons that constitute his style and images. Over the years, Rosi has offered us films that trace an intricate path between the real and the fictive, the factual and the imagined. The Cinema of Paolo Sorrentino Russell Kilbourn, 2020-06-16 Paolo Sorrentino, director of *Il Divo* (2008) and *The Great Beauty* (2013) and creator of the HBO series *The Young Pope* (2016), has emerged as one of the most compelling figures in twenty-first-century European film. La voce del reale Alma Miletto, 2023-11-24T00:00:00+01:00 Tra le diverse forme di narrazione assunte dal cinema, quella del documentario fa della parola filmata il perno del racconto. Ancora oggi la voce documentaria – per eccellenza “la voce off” del cinema – viene legata a quella onnisciente, didascalica, asettica del reportage. La nostra percezione di spettatori, assuefatta agli stilemi dell’imperante codice televisivo, sembra spesso non cogliere le radicali evoluzioni che, a partire dalla modernità, l’elemento vocale ha compiuto nel narrare il reale (Godard, Marker, Resnais, Rouch, Varda, Sokurov, Herzog; o, in Italia, Pasolini, Mangini, De Seta). Il presente volume propone una decostruzione dell’idea tradizionale di voce

documentaria, focalizzando la riflessione sul documentario italiano dell'ultimo ventennio (Marcello, Marazzi, Frammartino, Comodin, Ferrente, Savona) e sul perché l'elemento vocale applicato a quello che, non senza ambiguità, definiamo "cinema del reale" costituisca uno dei terreni di maggior sperimentazione del complesso rapporto tra piano dell'immagine e piano del linguaggio. A partire dal neologismo oromedialità, si indagano le due opposte tendenze che attraversano la "voce del reale" nel nostro presente: da una parte, essa appare compromessa con il ricco impasto mediale delle narrazioni in cui è coinvolta; dall'altra, sembra sempre più recuperare un carattere di "carnalità" nella sua esposizione orale, svelando l'instabilità emotiva e/o materiale della sua performance.
